POSITION MISSION: (The essence of the job)

Create a lesson plan or activity aimed at middle school students called “Life Cycle of a Live Event Industry Project.” This activity will be distributed to middle school teachers as a tool used to give an overview of the events designed and created within the Rock Lititz Community. The focus will be to highlight the jobs in our industry and the skills and traits needed to be successful at a Rock Lititz company.

POSITION OUTCOME:

- Meet and interview employees of the Rock Lititz Community (ATOMIC, TAIT, Clair, etc.) to gain an overview of the industry.
- During interviews, highlight 6 – 8 key jobs which are required to get a show out the door and onto the tour.
- Of the 6 – 8 jobs selected, create a list of 3 – 5 skills needed to be successful in the position. Skills can be interpersonal or ones requiring some type of additional training.
- After gathering information, create an activity which middle school students can complete in order to determine interest and ability in the highlighted jobs.
