## Program Details

- The 2022 Summer Learning Program will run from June 29th - August 10<sup>th</sup>
- The Live Instruction schedule will tentatively be Monday-Thursday from 9:30-10:30am and 11:00- 12:00pm.
- The Virtual Academic Teacher role is 20 hours per week; including 8 hours of live instruction and 12 hours designated for planning, group enrichment activities, 1:1 support for students, family engagement & coaching/collaborating.
- Virtual teacher training will take place June 29th -30th.
- The first student day will take place on July 5<sup>th</sup>. The last student day will take place on August 5<sup>th</sup>.
- August 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> will be teacher wrap-up days.
- To complete the employment process, all **NEW** candidates must be willing to travel to the United Way of Lancaster County office located at 1910 Harrington Drive, Lancaster PA 17601 prior to 6/1/2022 to complete paperwork. Returning teachers will not need to visit United Way in person.

- Bachelor's degree is required; college students pursuing teaching certificate with student teaching experience also considered
- Valid state (elementary / middle-school literacy / middle-school math) teaching certification or satisfactory record of student teaching experience
- Previous and relevant experience in utilizing and implementing data-driven instructional practices
- Experience in the use of technology (computer/Internet) for assessment and instruction
- Knowledge of differentiated instructional practices and strategies
- Drive to improve the minds and lives of scholars within the community
- Mastery of and enthusiasm for (literacy / math / literacy and math) academic standards and instructional rigor
- Excellent organizational and communication skills
- Love and respect for children
- Evidence of efficacy and willingness to be a team player
